

## DIRECTIONS TO VERMONT HOUSE FROM BURLINGTON AIRPORT:

Start out going south on Airport DR toward Elizabeth ST. for 0.4 mile.

Airport DR becomes Kennedy DR. Continue for 1.5 miles

KENNEDY DR becomes ramp. Drive 0.2 mile.

Merge onto I-189 S. for 1.2 miles.

Follow signs for Route 7 South/ Shelburne Road. Continue on US 7 South for 36.1 miles.

Approximately 3 miles south of Middlebury, turn LEFT and follow VT-125 towards East Middlebury. Continue to follow VT-125. After 4 miles, pass the Ripton Country Store on the right and the Chipman Inn on the left, and continue for approximately three more miles. You will see Middlebury College's Bread Loaf campus (a series of yellow cottages and then a large white house on the left set back in a field). Turn into the very next driveway (#4449) after the white house on the left. You will see a wooden gate, stone wall and a green house.

Time: About 1 hour 13 minutes. Distance: About 49 miles. Ripton, VT 05766

## DIRECTIONS TO VERMONT HOUSE FROM N.Y. THRUWAY:

Follow New York Thruway North towards Albany

Take Thruway exit 24 onto the Northway (U.S. 87 North) toward Montreal

Take Northway exit 20 (Fort Anne/Whitehall)

At stoplight, turn left onto Rte 9 North

Drive ½ mile. At light, turn right onto Rte 149 East

Drive 11.5 miles into Fort Ann. At light, turn left onto Rte 4 East.

Drive 22.1 miles on Rt 4 East (through Whitehall and into Vermont) and take exit 4 (Route 30 -Castleton/Middlebury exit).

Drive 15.2 miles on Route 30 north, then turn right onto Route 73 toward Brandon.

Drive 5.8 miles east on Route 73 to Brandon.

In Brandon, turn left onto U.S. Route 7 North toward Middlebury.

Drive north on U.S. Route 7 for 12 miles and turn right onto Rte 125 East.

Drive approximately 8 miles on Route 125 East through East Middlebury and Ripton.

After you pass the Ripton Country Store on the right and the Chipman Inn on the left, continue for approximately three miles. You will see Middlebury College's

Bread Loaf campus (a series of yellow cottages and then a large white house on the left set back in a field). Turn into the very next driveway after the white house on the left. You will see a wooden gate, a stone wall, a green house and #4449.

### DIRECTIONS TO VERMONT HOUSE VIA NEW YORK'S TACONIC PARKWAY

Take the Taconic Parkway north to Route 295 (Chatham).

Turn right onto 295 East for about 8 miles, then bear left onto CR-30, Queechee Lake Drive, for about 1.4 miles. This is a shortcut to Route 22. (If you miss the short cut, you'll turn left when you come to Route 22.)

Turn left onto Route 22 and continue for approximately 33 miles.

Turn right onto Route 7 and travel 3.6 miles. Take the Bennington By-Pass to VT-279 and connect to US-7, a total of about 5.1 miles.

Continue north on Route 7 for approx. 82 miles.

Turn right onto Route 125 and travel east for about 7 miles. (In 4 miles, you'll pass the Ripton General Store and community buildings. After another 2.5 miles you'll come upon the Breadloaf campus, a series of mustard colored wooden buildings.) You are almost there. At the end of the open field on the left side of the road, there's a fence, a row of trees, then our driveway and #4449.

### DIRECTIONS TO THE VERMONT HOUSE FROM MASSACHUSETTS:

Follow Interstate 89 or 91 North and continue north on Interstate 89 outside of White River Junction, Vermont.

Exit Interstate 89 at Exit 3 in Bethel, Vermont.

Travel west on Vermont Route 107 to Vermont Route 100 North.

Travel north on Vermont Route 100 to Vermont Route 125 in Hancock.

Travel west on Vermont Route 125, passing the Middlebury College Snow Bowl. The Vermont House (painted green) is approximately 1.8 miles beyond the Snow Bowl on the right side of Route 125. You will note a stone wall at the top of a small bank by the road, then turn right into #4449.

Immediately beyond the Vermont House you will see Middlebury College's Bread Loaf Campus.
